Code of conduct for scientists (Small Island Project, Ponza)

- The scientists should read the protocol, (http://www.inanellamentoponza.it/english.asp?page=protocollo), well in advance of the start of the activities.
- 2. On your first day at the Research Center, please arrive at least 30 minutes before starting your activities to sign the official documents and to pay the CISCA fee.
- **3.** While sampling at the nets or in the field, please position yourself at the nets in a way that does not interfere with the catching operations at the net and the standardization procedures during catching.
- **4.** While sampling at the net, avoid excessive noise that could interfere with the catching operations at the net and the standardization procedures during catching.
- **5.** All experimental procedures and collection of biological samples from birds must be previously authorized by the Scientific Committee.
- **6.** The Research Center should always be kept clean. Do not litter and leave cigarettes, plastic, papers and other trashes on the ground. There are special trash containers available at the Center and they should be used and emptied regularly.
- **7.** Do not leave personal belongings on the ringing table. Jackets and backpacks should be left in the ringing house. The station cannot be made responsible for lost or stolen items.
- 8. Smoking is not permitted at the ringing table and around the ringing tent.
